Scarf With A Twist

Two easy-to-knit lace scarfs twist together to create some accessory magic.

When choosing yarns for your scarf, a cotton yarn in a worsted or chunky weight, knit with a larger needle size than required, is ideal.

The scarfs (as shown in photo on ML114 Flowers and Fences pullover pattern) are knit in a cotton worsted weight yarn using Size 6mm (US10/CAN4) needles.

Knit two scarfs in contrasting or coordinating colors. One scarf should measure three-quarters the length of the other.

Finished Size (as shown in photo)

Width x Length of Orange Scarf (O)

3" x 68"/8cm x 172cm

Width x Length of Blue Scarf (B)

3" x 51"/8cm x 130cm

Materials

Worsted weight yarn.

Needle Size 6mm (US10/CAN4)

20 decorative beads for trim (optional)

Instructions

Cast on 14 sts, or an even amount of sts.

Row 1 Knit to last st, p1.

Row 2 Sl1 kwise, *yo, k2tog; rep from *, end p1.

Rep Row 2 until scarf measures 51"/130cm for short scarf (B), or 68"/172cm for long scarf (O).

Next row Bind off all sts kwise.

Finishing

Attach beads to ends of scarfs, using invisible thread.

Abbreviations

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1. Place the shorter scarf (B/blue) on the center point of the longer scarf (O/orange). From the center point, the one length of B and the two lengths of O are equal.



2. Braid together the one length of B and the two lengths of O, until 6"/15cm from scarf ends.



3. When finished braiding the three lengths, tie the two scarf ends of O together in a simple knot.



4. Place scarf around neck. Thread the remaining longer end of B through the simple knot of the scarf ends of O.



5. Tie the long and short scarf ends of B in a simple knot to secure.



6. Place the tied ends at back of neck, allowing the longer length of B to sit at the front.
